Easter Activities

Hold an egg hunt - you don't need real eggs, you could cut and decorate egg shapes and hide those, for extra fun you could write different numbers on the back and the winner is the person who has the highest total.

Can you design and describe your dream Easter Egg, would it be made of chocolate or something completely different, I really like cheese so I would love a cheese Easter egg!

Can you create a spring / Easter themed word search for someone else to complete? There are websites which can help you but you can draw one out on a piece of paper - you'll need a ruler!.

Can you make a pop-up Easter card for a family member? There are lots of ideas and instructions on the internet.

Can you write a poem about Easter or spring? You could write an acrostic poem (when the first line starts with a letter from the word e.g. Sunny days are on their way, Playing outside with my friends all day, R.....I... N... G...).

Design a family board game and play it with the people in your house, make sure you write the rules down so everyone knows how to play.

Get busy in the kitchen (with an adult) - you could make Chocolate Easter nests (recipe in the Home Learning Section) or maybe you could search for a recipe online to follow. Why not ask your family what they like to eat and design a meal for everyone.
