Your younger brother or sister is upset because their favourite toy is broken. You have enough money to buy them a new one, but it would mean you could not buy the toy that you were saving for.


What do you do?

What do you do?


You find some money in the school playground. You really want to buy some chocolate from the tuck shop.

What do you do?




A friend tells you to throw a stone at somebody's window. They say that the person who lives in the house is not very nice. You don't know the person who lives there.
